'Lady Filmy Stern' was the brainchild of Edward Bawden and Eric Ravilious along with their wives over many nights spend in a small, unelectrified cottage in Great Bardfield. After their friend Tom Hennell was discharged from Maudsley Hospital following a nervous breakdown, they encouraged him to put





words to their story. Out of that, the book 'Lady Filmy Stern' was born. It took three attempts for the book with its illustartions to be accepted by a publisher (including a period during the Second World War when preliminary sketches were hidden in a well). In 1979, the book was finally published, however it required several additional images to match the pagination. This composition is one of those.

[AMERICAN REVOLUTION] Collection of Letters: **CORNWALLIS, Charles, Lord:** Two autograph letters Signed to: Lieutenant Colonel Alexander Stewart (16th July, 1781: It is not improbable but I shall soon be with you in South Carolina..) & (Jan 2nd 1784). A full transcript of both letters is available; Lieutenant Colonel Alexander Stewart: (Battle of Eutaw Springs): An eight A4 page letter dated: Eutaws, 9th Sept 1781 "Copy of my outlook letter to Lord Cornwallis, after the action at the Eutaws 8th Sept 1781" [NOT **SIGNED**]: "My Lord, With particular salutation I have the honor to inform your Lordship that on the morning of the 8th instant I was attacked by the rebel general Green with all the force he could collect in this province and North Carolina- and after an obstinate engagement which lasted near two hours I totally? Defeated him..."; A copy of a three page letter from Stewart to Cornwallis, Signed; Two A4 sheets: 1- A return of the number of officers, non commissioned officers, rank & file, sent out on a shooting? Party from the army commanded by Lieutenant Colonel Alexander Stewart on the morning before the action at Eutaws Sept 8th 1781; 2- A return of the number of officers, non commissioned officers, rank & file, in the action at Eutaws Sept 8th 1781 commanded by Lieutenant Colonel Alexander Stewart; A Copy of a Letter from Lord Kamdon to Col. Balfour, headed: Ninety Six, 27 June 1781. Mentions pursuing "Greene" (Nathanael Greene) passed the broad river at Fiskdan Ford... (With a typed transcript). The original letter with tears to the folds; PLUS: Five other letters from around the same period. The first use of Schneeballen ('Snowball') decoration was by J.J. Kaendler in June 1740 and in 1742, a bowl, cover and stand was given to the dauphin, son of Louis XV, with the same decoration (see Maureen Cassidy-Geiger Ed., *Fragile Diplomacy*, 2007, p.158, fig.7-25). The technique was revived in the mid-19th century across all manner of items from bowls to ewers. The present example is outstanding in both size and technique and is unusual in that the caged bird is polychrome decorated as opposed to being left white.
